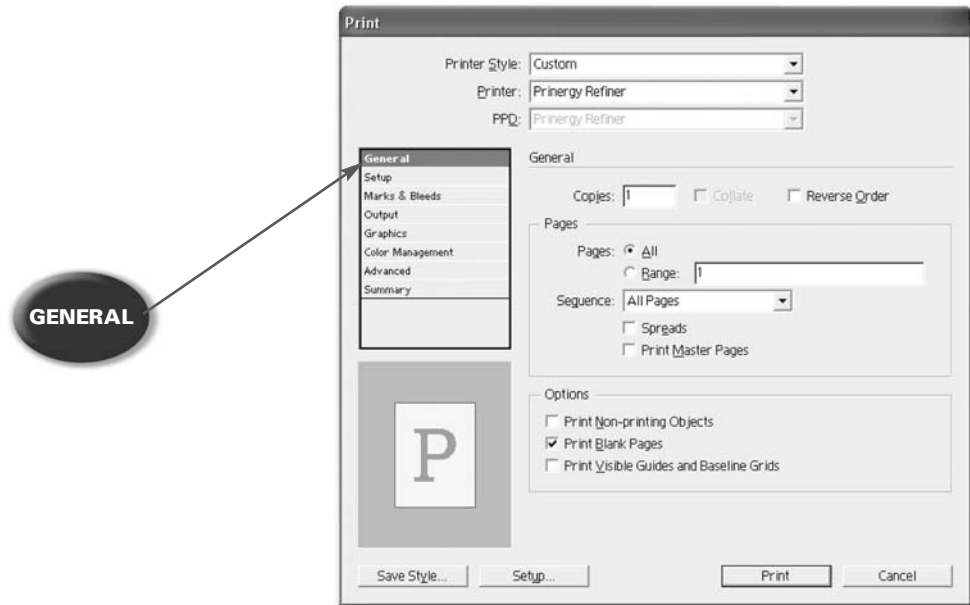


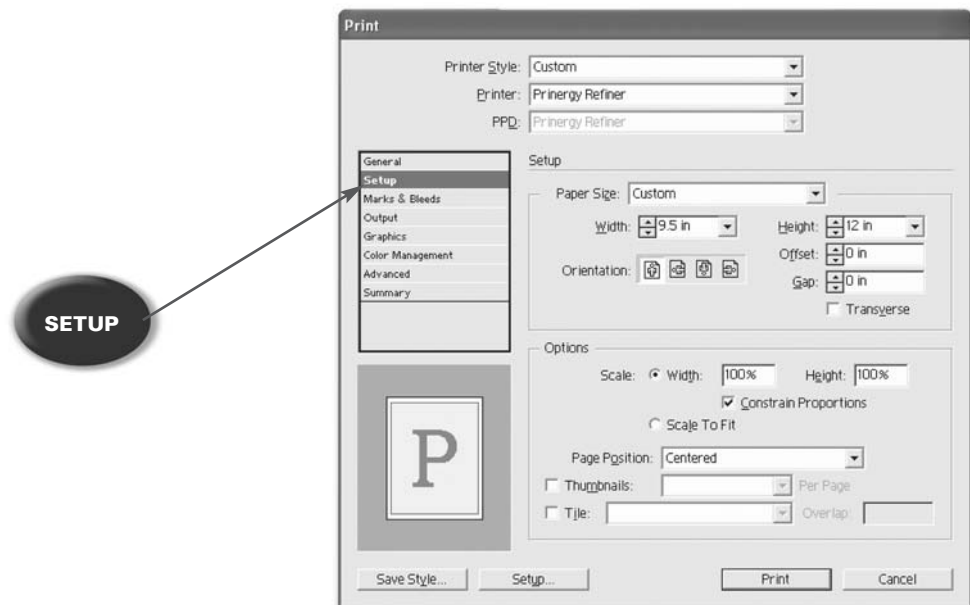
Creating PostScript files from PC InDesign 2.0

You will first need to download the **PCrefiner.ppd** available through your sales/customer service representative. Uncompress the file and place into your Documents and Settings folder. Second, download the **aps102eng.exe** file to your desktop. This file is an Adobe PostScript Driver Program used to create a Local Printer for the Prinergy PPD. Double click to open program and follow the instructions on screen. Select file when asked for a Local Port. When asked to select Printer Model, browse and choose the **PCrefiner.ppd** which was placed in the Documents and Settings Folder and continue with the instructions on screen. Use the following screen captures as your guide to creating a PostScript file prior to Distilling with Acrobat.

1. Select **PRINT** from the File menu. The following dialog box will appear:



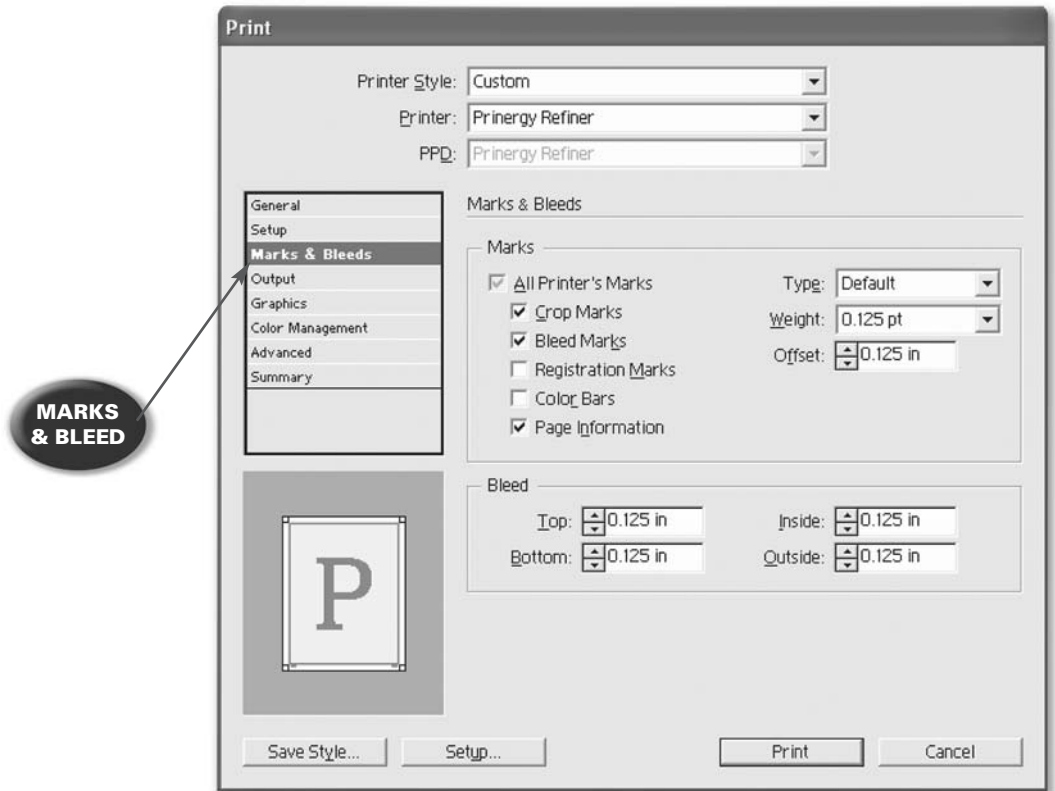
2. Match the settings as shown above, then select **SETUP** to continue.



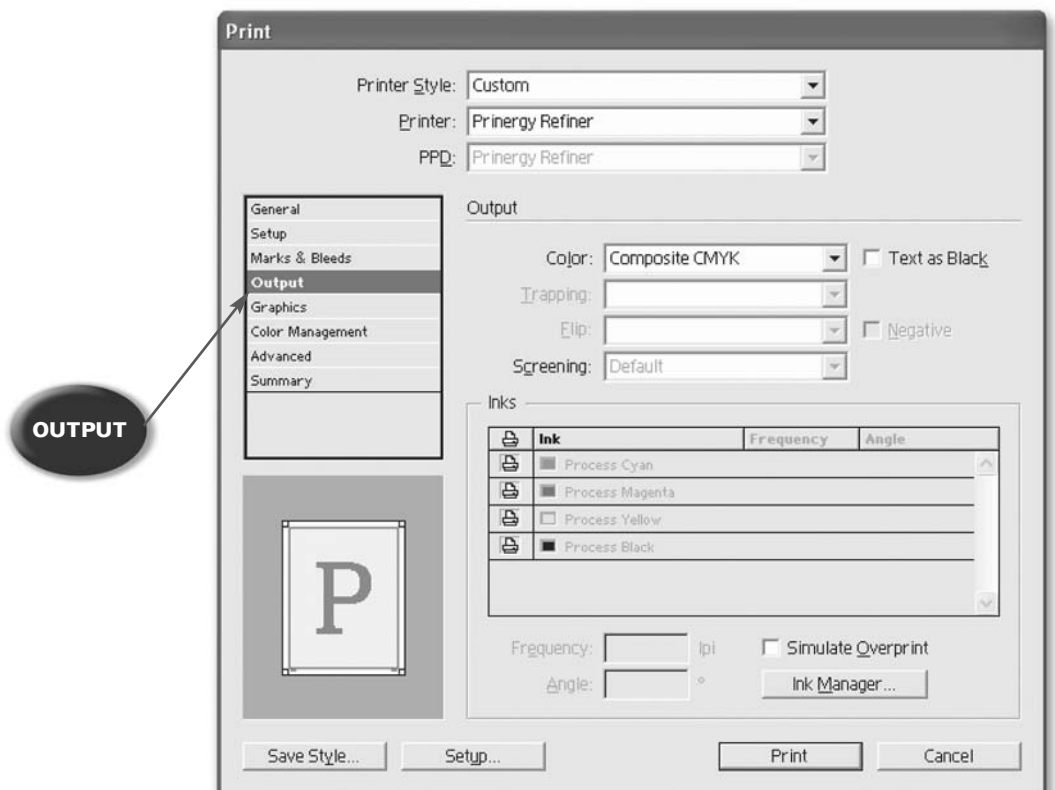
3. Under Paper Size select **Custom**. Adjust width and height to measure 1" larger than your actual document size (the example shown is for an 8.5" x 11" page). Match the other settings as shown.

POSTSCRIPT

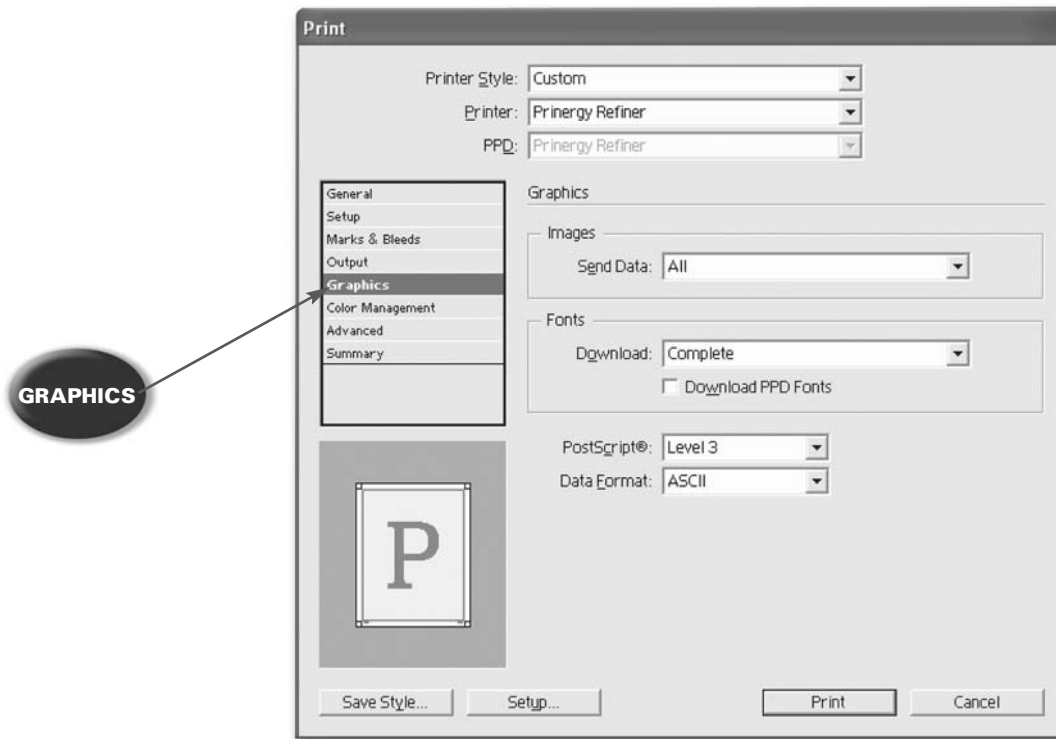
4. Select **MARKS & BLEEDS** to continue. Match the settings as shown below.



5. Select **OUTPUT** to continue. Match the settings as shown below.



6. Select **GRAPHICS** to continue. Match the settings as shown below.



7. Select the  button.

8. Name the file with the “.ps” file extension. Avoid using spaces, special characters, forward slashes or hyphens.



9. Select the  button to save your PostScript file.

Distilling PDF files from PostScript files

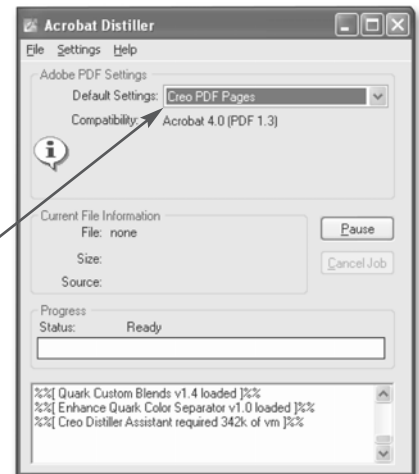
Copy the file “**CreoDistillerAssistant**” into your Documents and Settings / All Users / Documents / Adobe PDF 6.0 / Startup folder. **Note:** Delete any file named *Example.ps* from the Startup Folder. This file can interfere with the proper operation of the Creo Distiller Assistant.

Copy the file “**Creo PDF Pages.joboptions**” into your Document and Settings / All Users / Documents / Adobe PDF 6.0 / Settings Folder.

Restart Acrobat Distiller. **Note:** This software is compatible with Adobe Acrobat 4.0 (or newer) for Windows.

1. Drag and drop the PostScript file onto the Acrobat distiller window with “**Creo PDF Pages**” selected in the Job Options drop down window.

2. After the file has been distilled, you should have a PDF file with the same name in the same location as your PostScript file.

3. Please take a moment to open and view the file. The file should include **trim marks, bleeds, all images and fonts**, and look as you intended.
